Summary:

Multiple openings for the role of Lead SharePoint Developer with Lighthouse Computer Services, Inc., headquartered at 6 Blackstone Valley Place, Suite 205, Lincoln, RI 02865. Lead SharePoint Developers are hands-on, individual contributors, responsible for software application project development (not supervising others).

Responsibilities:

- Will design, architect, administer, and develop portal systems.
- Will set-up environments for testing and implementing applications, and participate in the testing process through test review and analysis.
- Will develop, program, implement, and configure Microsoft business applications, including SharePoint applications, utilizing the following: the Microsoft .NET Framework (to include C#, VB.NET, and ASP.NET); web application development (to include HTML, CSS, XML, SOAP, and Web Services); MS SQL Server; SharePoint; and SQL Server for database design, writing stored procedures and SQL scripts.
- Will also develop, configure, and troubleshoot internet, intranet, and extranet applications for SharePoint technologies and platforms.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree or foreign equivalent in Computer Science or Computer Applications; Information Technology, Information Management, or Information Systems (to include Computer or Management Information Systems); Engineering (to include Computer, Electronic, Electrical, Mechanical or Communication Engineering); or related field. Where merely Bachelor's-educated, would also require five years of progressive, post-baccalaureate experience (a) developing and implementing Microsoft technologies using the C#, VB.NET, and ASP.NET development languages; and (b) developing through the use of the Microsoft SharePoint platform.
- Alternatively may qualify with a Master's Degree or foreign equivalent in Computer Science or Computer Applications; Information Technology, Information Management, or Information Systems (to include Computer or Management Information Systems); Engineering (to include Computer, Electronic, Electrical, Mechanical or Communication Engineering); or related field. Master's-qualified applicants would, in addition, need to have two years of experience (a) developing and implementing Microsoft technologies using the C#, VB.NET, and ASP.NET development languages; and (b) developing through the use of the Microsoft SharePoint platform.
- Require strictly domestic, regional travel in New England up to one hundred percent of the time (absent any expense to consultants). Extent to which must travel, however, will admittedly vary; can be one hundred percent continuously over an extended stretch. Travel will be to various client sites within New England; specific assignments cannot be predicted in advance (change over time).
- Must live in Greater Boston, Greater Lowell, Greater Worcester, Greater Providence, Central Massachusetts, or Massachusetts' MetroWest, North or South Shore regions.

As such, all client sites to which can potentially be assigned are reachable by car (as standard daily commute); temporary relocation, thus, not required. Telecommuting (working remotely from home) is permitted. But workers will also be needed at client sites, as stated, as well as company headquarters, as needed.
